

One of the most frequent questions I get from people is, "what is God's will for my life?" This question can be brought on by frustration over the current situation. It can be caused by graduation or a move or some other life change. It can be brought on by God leading us through His Word.

I always appreciate the question. It shows a willfulness to be led by God. It shows a trust that God is actively working in our lives. When that question comes because of time in God's Word it shows an attentiveness to God's mission and will being done among us and through us.



Take Abram (Abraham before God changed his name) for example. God spoke to Abram. Abram listened. God's will for Abram and for countless others was done. Now the LORD said to Abram, "Go from your country and your kindred and your father's house to the land that I will show you. And I will make of you a great nation, and I will bless you and make your name great, so that you will be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and him who dishonors you I will curse, and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed." So Abram went, as the LORD had told him. Genesis 12:1-4a

What God did not do for Abram was fill in all the pieces and tell Abram in detail what He had planned. Abram, GO! And He did. He packed everything and everyone and headed out on a journey where he did not know the destination. When the time was right God filled Abram in on more of His will.

Discerning God's will for our lives is grounded in His Word. He talked to Abram but for us He speaks through His Word. God's will for our lives is guided by Hebrews 11:1. Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen. We are guided by Matthew 28:20. God has promises to be with you always. We are guided by Romans 8:28. He has promised that all things work together for the good of those that love Him. Trusting in His Word and promises, we make decisions for our future and the future of our families.

When we are seeking God's will for our lives is there only one right decision to make? No. You have many talents and gifts. You have many vocations. You have many choices in how and where to serve Him. Consider your options. What will be best for you and your family? Which choice will I be really good at? How can I glorify God with my choices? After you have answered those, continue to pray and be in God's Word so His Holy Spirit can continue to guide you. Then, make your decision trusting in God that He will take care of you and provide for you all you need.

As you work through that process remember what Dr. Luther writes about the third petition of the Lord's Prayer. "Thy will be done on earth as it is in heaven." What does this mean? The good and gracious will of God is done even without our prayer, but we pray in this petition that it may be done among us also.

How is God's will done? God's will is done when He breaks and hinders every evil plan and purpose of the devil, the world and our sinful nature, which do not want us to hallow God's name or let His kingdom come; and when He strengthens and keeps us firm in His Word and faith until we die. This is His good and gracious will.

Wherever you end up remember this. "And when He (God) strengthens and keeps us firm in His Word and faith until we die. This is His good and gracious will." We have freedom in Christ when mapping out our future. Stay in His Word. Seek direction in prayer. Make the decision. God will keep His promises to you wherever you end up. Announcements will be read 5 minutes before church every Sunday.


